This session will answer the question “How do I know if I’m successful in my coaching work?” Measuring the impact of coaching cycles is a core practice for Student-Centered Coaching as it ensures that we are collecting evidence of student performance and teacher growth. This allows us to understand our efficacy as coaches, get feedback from teachers, and tell the story of coaching so that others will trust that the process is outcomes-based. Participants will learn:

- How to use the Results-Based Coaching Tool and coaching logs to document the impact of full and mini coaching cycles
- Strategies for collecting pre and post assessment data within coaching cycles
- Ideas for celebrating the impact of coaching cycles to increase teacher engagement
- How to navigate common challenges related to measuring the impact of Student-Centered Coaching
